1 HOST AND ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Regatta will be hosted and organized by Fleet 98 and Leatherlips Yacht Club. Please visit www.leatherlips.com for more information on Leatherlips Yacht Club.

2 RULES

The Regatta will be governed by rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, including the prescriptions of US SAILING, the rules of the Day Sailer Class Association, the Sailing Instructions, and this Notice of Race.

3 ELIGIBILITY

3.1 The regatta is open to all Day Sailer boats.

3.2 Eligibility to compete in the Regatta as Skipper is limited to Day Sailer Association Members who meet the Eligibility Requirements set forth in Section 2 of By-Law 2 of the By-Laws of the Day Sailer Association. Section 2.1(ii) of By-Law 2 provides that the Governing Board is authorized to make case-by-case decisions and exceptions concerning eligibility.

3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and sending it, together with the required fee of \$235, to the address listed below. All entries postmarked after June 1, 2010 must include an additional late fee of \$30. Registrations received after 15:30 EDT on Wednesday July 7, 2010 will not be accepted.

5 WEIGHING AND MEASURING

All boats shall be weighed, all sails to be used shall be declared and measured, rudder and centerboard profiles shall be checked, and spars shall be measured, in accordance with Section 6.2 of By-Law 2 of the By-Laws of the Day Sailer Association.

6 VENUE & SAILING AREA

Leatherlips Yacht Club is located at 9230 Shawnee Trail, Powell Ohio. All weighing and measuring, and most social events will be held at Leatherlips Yacht Club. All races will be held on Alum Creek Reservoir, approximately 10 minutes from Leatherlips Yacht Club.

7 SCORING

7.1 The NACR shall have a minimum of 3 races scheduled each day for the three days of racing. Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series for the NACR. When fewer than six races have been completed in the NACR, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. This changes rule A2.

7.2 The Junior NACR will have 3 races scheduled. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series for the Junior NACR. In the Junior NACR, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. This changes rule A2.

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be made available at registration.

9 BOAT STORAGE

Arrangements have been made for boat storage in the water at the Alum Creek Sailing Association docks.

10 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the top ten finishers, both skipper and crew, and perpetual trophies will be given in categories as defined in the DSA Handbook.

11 JUNIOR NACR

The Day Sailer Junior North American Championship Regatta will be held on Wednesday, July 7, 2010. Skippers must be 18 years old or younger as of July 6, 2010. There will be no entry fee for this event. Prizes will be awarded to the top three finishers and a perpetual trophy will be given to the winner. Participants in the Junior NACR shall plan to have their boat weighed and measured on Tuesday, July 6, 2010 if at all possible.

12 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

13 DISCLAIMER

Competitors participate in the NACR and Junior NACR at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in connection with, or prior to, during or after the NACR and Junior NACR.
